Upland Brewing Company, Bloomington, Indiana

- **Upland Wheat** - Light on the tongue and easy going, our Wheat Ale is made with 50% wheat malt and spiced with coriander and orange peel
- **Upland Dragonfly IPA** - is a malty and hoppy brew. Note the clean malty fullness on the front of the palate with fruity citrus overtones, attributable to our special hops.
- **Upland Valley Weizen** - A German-style wheat with hints of tart apple, banana, and sweet clove spice
- **Upland Bad Elmer's Porter** - Creamy chocolate flavors combine with a lightly roasted finish and superb body to balance this traditional brown porter. A fragrant malt/hop aroma and herbaceous hop flavor complete this highly quaffable ale.



New Albanian Brewing, New Albany, Indiana

- **Saison II** – Version I was quickly released at the brewpub, reformulated to this version making this the debut for this Wallonian style Saison.
- **Phoenix Kentucky Komon** - The Louisville area's only indigenous beer style during the 19th-century heyday of local brewing was an everyday quaffer with adjuncts (often a percentage of sour mash from corn), generally dark, brewed and consumed quickly, and seldom spotted far from the source brewery.
- **Bob's Old 15-B** - When NABC first brewed Bob Capshew's competition-winning homebrewed Porter, the reaction was so favorable that we decided to continue doing it. When the Beer Judge Certification Program unexpectedly altered its numbering system for style categories and subcategories, Bob's became "old" rather than having to select a new number.
- **Hoptimus** – This Double IPA weighs in at a hefty 9% made with Northern Brewer, Nugget, Fuggle, Cascade (dry hopped with Fuggle & Cascade)



Brugge Beer, Broad Ripple, Indiana

- **Brugge White** - has a quenching tart background with sweet fruity finish reminiscent of tangerine and lemon
- **Brugge Tripel de Ripple**- A Belgian-style tripel, with a huge citrus aroma, and a nice spicy and wheaty flavor.
- **Brugge Black** - Brussels style black ale is a newly rediscovered Belgian ale that has roots traced to the sixteenth century



Wabash Valley Brewing, Terre Haute, Indiana

- **Hazy Wheat Ale** - Hazy Days Wheat Ale combines the robust flavor of malted barley with the crisp, clean taste of wheat.
- **Harvest Amber** - Made with only barley, hops, yeast and water, Harvest Amber contains no corn or rice adjuncts, ingredients that are normally reserved for cheaper, lesser quality beers.
- **Gangster Pale Ale** - you don't have to be Dillinger to enjoy this classic American Pale Ale built on hops from the Pacific Northwest. Savor Gangster's bold, clean taste in peace.
- **Cannonball Porter** - delivers a rich and malty sweet flavor worthy of the great mythical train herself.



Powerhouse Brewing Company, Columbus, Indiana

- **Workingman Wheat** - A classic German Hefe-Weiss style with a light straw color and subtle banana and clove flavors. Great after a day of hard work!



Schlafly Beer, St. Louis, Missouri

- **Raspberry Hefeweizen** - This unfiltered wheat ale is flavored with raspberry for a delicious summer refresher.
- **Dry Hopped APA** - An American Pale Ale with a hearty dose of hop bitterness, flavor and aroma. We add hops directly into the finished beer to boost the fresh, fruity flavor and aroma of American hops.
- **# 15** - Our 15th Anniversary Ale! A medium-bodied amber-colored ale with a delightful wheaty flavor and a fruity, spicy finish.

- **India Brown** – Our Tap Room Brewer Brennan has hand crafted this ale to celebrate his marriage to the beautiful Natasha. This unique brew has the color of a brown ale, but the aroma of an American style IPA. Dry Hopped with Cascade and Willamette, this beer will prove just how complex a brown ale can be.



Barley Island Brewing, Noblesville, Indiana

- **Sheet Metal Blonde** - Style of Belgian Wit beer that is light pale in color, contains added spices, and best if served with a slice of orange
- **Barfly IPA** - The hop character is citrusy, floral, and fruity (orange/grapefruit) from the use of Summit hops. The complex malt flavor profile supports the strong hop flavor.
- **Dirty Helen Brown Ale** - Dirty Helen, legendary tavern owner, supposedly could out-swear anybody in town. An American original, just like our tavern style Brown Ale.
- **Bourbon Barrel Aged Oatmeal Stout** - Our Oatmeal Stout aged in bourbon whiskey barrels from Buffalo Trace Distillery in Frankfort, Kentucky.

Bell's Brewing Company, Kalamazoo, Michigan

- **Oberon** - An American wheat ale brewed with Saaz hops. Spicy and fruity, Oberon is the color and scent of a summer afternoon
- **Amber Ale** - is made from mostly pale malt and some Munich and caramel malts
- **Two Hearted Ale** - India Pale Ale style well suited for Hemingway-esque trips to the Upper Peninsula. American malts and enormous hop additions give this beer a crisp finish and incredible floral hop aroma.
- **Lager** - A refreshingly crisp and clean pilsner beer brewed with Pils and Munich malts.
- **Cherry Stout** - A rich and powerful beer with tart cherry appeal, make this a fine stout.
- **Java Stout** - A marriage of Sumatra's best with rich chocolate and roasted malt provides for a truly enlightening beer.

Browning's Brewery, Louisville, Kentucky

- **Louis XVI Guillotine ESB** - a medium bodied copper colored ale. Each batch uses a different single variety of hops to impart assertive bitterness and a mild aroma. So raise an extra pint of this special ale to Louis' bitter end.
- **Oatmeal Stout** -



Oaken Barrel Brewing Company, Greenwood, Indiana

- **Indiana Amber** - represents a well-balanced blend of malt and hops, which is immediately noticeable beginning with the deep aroma.
- **Alabaster** - Tart and refreshing, this traditional Belgian Wheat Ale tastes great in any environment

- **Razz Wheat** - Razz-Wheat receives its award-winning flavor and eye-catching color from fresh Oregon raspberries. This beer provides a refreshing finish aimed at your sweet side.
- **Gnaw Bone Pale Ale** - With a considerable amount of fragrance hops bestowed upon this sensation, Gnaw Bone backs up its characteristic bitterness and spicy hop flavor with a nose-rattling citrus aroma.
- **Snake Pit Porter** - Not for the uninitiated, this robust ale is dark and flavorful with a mouthfeel edging towards the chewy side



Cumberland Brews, Louisville, Kentucky

- **Summer Wheat** - An American style wheat ale, made with 50% wheat. A touch of caramel malts is added to give it a nice orange hue
- **Cream Ale** – American style Cream Ale, light bodied and mildly hopped.
- **Yerba Mate Pale Ale** – A pale ale with a South American influence. The infusion of organic Yerba Mate contributes a floral aroma that compliments the American Hops. Organic malt provides the malty backbone to balance this amber beer.
- **Celtic Stout** – Dry Irish stout, with a pleasant roast character.
- **Pale Ale** – Full bodied American pale ale. Amber in color and balanced with American aroma hops
- **IPA** - Golden IPA with plenty of hop flavor from the Columbus, Simcoe and Cascade hops
- **Double Eclipse** - Traditional Belgian Double. Blend of malts, amber sugar and raisins provide the rich malty flavor, while the Trappist yeast provides the spicy Belgian character.



Three Floyds, Munster, Indiana

- **Pride & Joy Mild Ale** - Medium bodied ale offers a sweet maltiness, lower alcohol, and just the right amount of hops, providing a pleasingly gentle session ale.
- **Alpha King Pale Ale** - Big American Pale Ale with citrusy aroma- a hop lover's cult beer and Three Floyds' flagship beer Brewed with Centennial, Cascade & Warrior Hops
- **Robert the Bruce Scotch Ale** - A big malty body from chocolate and roasted malts, well balanced with just the right combination of hops.
- **Blonde Behemoth** - Complex caramel sweetness is well balanced by generous hopping, delivering an intense, smooth drinking experience. Intense fruity caramel malts, citrus hops, and alcohol notes waft up to tickle your senses.
- **Brian Boru** - is a very rich caramelly ale with toffee, citrus, and pineapple aroma. Brian Boru is brewed with several malts and Amarillo hops. Slainte!

- **Alpha Klaus** - brewed with English chocolate malt and Mexican sugar and of course tons of strange American hops!



Bluegrass Brewing Company, Louisville, Kentucky

- **American Pale Ale** - this rich, copper colored ale features a full-bodied, hoppy flavor supported by generous amounts of malt. The recipe was carefully developed for the local palate and has become a favorite of BBC's regular guests.
- **Amber (The Beer Formerly known as Alt)** - A medium bodied amber ale with a mild hop finish, this well balanced beer will appeal to beer connoisseurs as well as the average beer drinker.
- **Dark Star Porter** - then makes the first turn with "chocolate malt" goodness. Domestic and imported - EAST KENT GOLDING - hops bring this beer down the homestretch to a spicy hop finish.
- **Jefferson Reserve Bourbon Barrel Stout** - Aged for two to three months in McLain & Kyne Jefferson's Reserve bourbon barrels, this stout is a richly flavored sipping beer, with a smooth chocolate taste and a hint of bourbon.



Mishawaka Brewing Company, Mishawaka, Indiana

- **Four Horsemen Irish Red** - Four Horsemen is brewed as an Irish style Red Ale using six malts and three hop varieties.
- **INDIANA Pale Ale** - has a golden amber color and is brewed using only American grown ingredients including four malts and three hop varieties.
- **HopHead Ale** - brewed with five different hop varieties added at five different times to achieve the balance of IBU's, flavor and aroma.



Warbird Brewing Company, Fort Wayne, Indiana

- **Mustang Gold Ale** - the perfect entry point into the world of "drinkable" craft beers. Ultra-smooth all-malt flavor, without any extra color or aftertaste.
- **T-6 Red Ale** - has the flavor and balance of a wonderfully hand-crafted all malt beer. Beautiful red color, smooth flavor, no aftertaste.
- **Thunderbolt Wheat** - a traditional unfiltered German-style "hefeweizen", with German Wheat malt, German hops, and German Wheat yeast.
- **Shanty Irish Ale** - is a full-bodied Irish style Red Ale featuring rich red color and smooth malty sweetness.
- **Warhawk Pale Ale** – Brewed with Cascade Hops, premium 2-row malt and 3 specialty malts to give this beer the full malt complexity required to balance a "hoppy" beer.



Dark Horse Brewing, Marshall, Michigan

- **Reserve Black Beer** - Each batch is brewed with heavy roasted and chocolate malts to give this beer its unique flavors of coffee and chocolate. The color of this beer is black, and when poured into a glass it will have a deep brown head of foam.
- **Raspberry Ale** - A light ale made with 100% real raspberries in every batch.
- **Cream Stout** - This beer is made with milk sugar (lactose), which gives this beer a nice creamy mouth feel, which mingles with hints of chocolate and roasty flavors.
- **Smoked Stout** - Brewed with all malted barley and peat malt (smoked malt). This beer is full bodied with chocolate, roasted barley flavors, and a smoky almost BBQ finish
- **Oatmeal Stout** - is full bodied with hints of chocolate, roasted barley, coffee flavors and a nice creamy head.



Brooklyn Brewery, Brooklyn, New York

- **Brown Ale** - uses pale, crystal, chocolate, and black malts to attain a complex creamy texture. It is more heavily hopped than its British forbears.
- **EIPA** - uses English malts and hops to brew his EIPA in the classic, heavily-hopped style of the 19th century beers created for British soldiers serving in India.
- **Lager** - displays a firm malt center supported by a fine bitterness and floral hop aroma. Caramel malts show in the finish.
- **Summer Ale** - from premium English barley malt, which gives this light-bodied golden beer a fresh breadly flavor. German and American hops lend a light, crisp bitterness and a citrus/floral aroma resulting in a beer with a very sunny disposition.



Hoppin' Frog Brewery, Akron, Ohio

- **Black & Tan** - Our IPA and Stout converge for a really great flavor combination to create a rich and robust Black-Tan.
- **Hefeweizen** - Traditional German-style, unfiltered wheat beer, with a lively balanced flavor.
- **Hoppin to Heaven IPA** - with a spicy assertive and citrusy American hop character balanced with a full-bodied malt taste.
- **Silk Porter** - Dark, robust and silky-smooth, with many flavors of roasted, toasted and caramel malts.
- **Gulden Fraug** - A slightly spicy and complex flavor makes this European celebration-style beer unique and refreshing.




Brewery Ommegang, Cooperstown, New York

- **Ommegang Rare VOS** - has the aroma of spicy orange blossoms and the mellow flavor of caramel malt with a dry, hop finish.
- **Ommegang Hennepin** - is bright and lively in your mouth with a warming mix of spicy gingersnap and citrusy hops.
- **Ommegang Three Philosophers** - is a unique and masterful blend of strong malty ale and authentic Belgian Kriek.



Imports by World Class Beverages

- **Unibroue Blanche de Chambly** - produced from an interesting blend of unmalted Quebec wheat and pale barley malt, to which spices and natural aromatics are added, along with a light hopping.
- **Bavik Pils** - A light flavored beer, smooth and malty. Clean finish, with a light malt aftertaste.
- **Zatec Lager** - Medium-bodied; natural, soft conditioning; hedonistic fresh herbal aroma; a flavor that is the best of fresh-baked bread, fields of grain, and spice, with a solid malt middle. Clean, sparkling, and quintessentially thirst-quenching.
- **Ayinger Alt Dunkel** - A satisfying, malty taste, with coffee-ish tones and a hint of plummy fruitiness in the finish.
- **Spaten Optimator** - Deep and dark colored, rich and malty taste Spaten's strongest beer, considered by many beer connoisseurs as the world's finest dark beer.
- **Spaten Lager** - Golden in color with a well balanced hop-flavor. The full rounded body is a superb balance between hops and a malty sweetness.

Beers from Cavalier Distributing

- **Clipper City Holy Sheet** - Aromatic and very full bodied, the beer will pour a deep burgundy in color and feature a rich, robust depth of malt character.
- **Clipper City Red Sky at Night** - A potent yet delicate ale, brewed with a unique Belgian yeast which develops a spicy, fruity flavor. Enormously complex.
- **Butte Creek Organic Porter** - This true-to-style porter has a full bodied malty flavor balanced with a crisp hop bitterness
- **Michigan High Seas IPA** - A skillful blend of three premium barley malts with generous amounts of Northern Brewer and Cascade Hops creates a special ale to satisfy even the most demanding palate
- **Celis White Ale** - seasoned with Curacao orange peel and coriander, and is brewed from a unique recipe first brewed in Belgium in 1453.

- **Schneider Aventinus** - very full-bodied, compact and yet fresh with a hint of caramel. It finishes with a light and delicate taste of bitters leaving behind a strong, smoothly rounded, sour impression
- **Weinstephan Vitus** - A light-colored, spicy single-bock wheat beer, for both beer lovers and the beer connoisseur.
- **Bitburger** - brewed with the best of ingredients in the same traditional way it has been for many, many years. The result is delicately tart and pleasantly bitter - with a strong hop taste
- **Saison Dupont** - is a beautifully balanced, complex beer that has a refreshing fruitiness and long, dry finish.
- **Krusovice** - Superior quality Czech malt, natural spring water from the Křivoklát Woods and hops from the Žatec area are used in the production of this beer



Wines from Crossroads Vintners

- **Huber (Austria, not Starlight, IN) Hugo Gruner** - sleek with nuances of minerals and slate and some surprising tastes of stone fruit.
- **Samantha Starr Chardonnay** - Medium straw in color, the nose shows balanced elements of tropical fruits and fresh citrus. On the palate it exhibits ripe bananas, peach and just a hint of toasty oak.
- **Ca'Tullio Pinot Grigio** - Crisp, with elegant fruity aromas of citrus, pear and apple, followed by grapefruit, melon and citrus peel flavors with honeysuckle and crisp apple.
- **Joel Gott Sauvignon Blanc** - exhibits aromas and flavors of passion fruit, melon, citrus, and hints of jasmine. The palate offers juicy sweet fruit that leads to a crisp, citrus clean and long finish.
- **Cartlidge & Browne Pinot Noir** - leaps from the glass with loads of baked chery/berry fruit character, along with anise, spice cake, and the 'beety' notes so appreciated in Pinot Noir
- **Quattro Mani Montepulciano** - lively with berry and cherry notes that dance on your palate.
